## Entrance Requirements

To enter the NROTC, an applicant must be a United States citizen, at least 17 years old at enrollment, physically qualified, and of sound character. Students may apply for enrollment during their first or second year of a four-year degree program at the University of Maine.

## University-Wide Programs

### Program Description

The Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps (NROTC) Program is for University of Maine students wishing to complement their education with a Navy training experience which can lead to a commission in the Navy or Marine Corps. The program is open to all University of Maine students who meet the entrance requirements listed to the left. Application and selection are made at the NROTC Unit on campus. There is no obligation until the junior year.

### Career Opportunities

Through the Naval ROTC, students can choose from the following schools and career paths: Navy Flight School, Nuclear Power School, Surface Warfare Officer School, Navy SEAL, Navy Diver, Navy Nurse Corps, or the United States Marine Corps.

### Specialized Information

The Department of Naval Science offers a minor in Naval Science. The minor requires the completion of 23 credit hours in Naval Science courses.

#### NROTC SCHOLARSHIPS

**Four-year scholarships** are available at the national level and may be applied for while in high school. See your guidance counselor, Navy Recruiter, or the NROTC office.

**Three-year** and **two-year scholarships** are available. Selection is based on grade point average, naval aptitude, physical readiness, mathematics and science performance, and ranking among other scholarship candidates.

- Monthly allowance

#### BENEFITS FOR ALL NROTC MEMBERS

All students who participate in NROTC may compete for scholarship benefits. In addition, they receive:
